In the Name of God Amen To all whom it may Concern I Dorcas Bateman of Little Humby in the County of Lincoln Spinster Do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament this 3rd day of August in the Year of our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and Seventy two and in the twelfth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign King George the third by the Grace of God King of Great Britain I do Give and Bequeath to my Brother Richard Bateman of Little Humby aforesaid the sum of Ten Pounds to be paid by my Executor and I do likewise Give and Bequeath to my Sister Sarah Chambers Wife of Edward Chambers Blacksmith of Welby in the County of Lincoln aforesaid ffive Pounds to be paid by my Executor and do likewise Give and Bequeath all my Wearing Apparrell and Linnen two be equally divided between my two Sisters and desire that my Legacys truly be paid by my Executor Twelve Months and one Day after my decease And I do make and Ordain my sister Mary Bateman of Little Humby aforesaid my whole and full Executor and this done according to my desire Do hereby Witness my hand and seal _ Dorcas Bateman and in the presence of _ John Spencer _ Richd Gant _ Robt Peach
