LCC Wills 1770/11

This is the last Will and Testament of me Mary Beagles of Holbeach in the County of Lincoln Widow, as follows. First I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Beagles the legacy or sum of ten pounds to be paid to her by my executor within twelve months next after my decease. Also I give and bequeath unto my son William Beagles the like legacy or sum of ten pounds of good and lawful money of Great Britain to be paid to him by my said executor herein after named within twelve months next after my decease. And I also give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Ancell the legacy or sum of five pounds of like lawful money to be paid to him by my said executor herein after named within twelve months next after my decease. And I also give and bequeath unto my son John Ancell the legacy or sum of five pounds of like lawful money to be paid to him by my said executor herein after named within twelve months next after my decease. And I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary the Wife of John Taulks the like legacy or sum of five pounds of good and lawful money to be paid to her by my said executor within twelve months next after my decease. And lastly I give and begueath unto my son Samuel Beagles all and singular my goods chattels live stock cattle personal estate and effect whatsoever and wherever the whereof I shall or may at the time of my decease be possessed off or any wages entitled unto. And I do hereby nominate constitute my said son Samuel Beagles sole and absolute executor of this my Will and I do declare these presents to be my last Will and Testament in witness whereof the said testatrix Mary Beagles have hereunto set my hand and seal this twelfth day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy.
